



A New-Kingdom glazed steatite scarab.

Circa: 1292-1190 BCE

Glazed steatite. $1.45 \times 1 \times 0.7 \text{ cm}$ ($0 \frac{5}{8} \times 0 \frac{3}{8} \times 0 \frac{1}{4}$ inches)

Egypt, New-Kingdom, Dynasty 19th, 1292-1190 BCE

Steatite scarab seal with fine naturalistic details: head, wings and legs on the back, and the reverse with a flat base inscribed with hieroglyphs: the sun disc (Ra), *ntr* (god) the divine falcon flanked with a cobra (Horakthy?), *nb* (Lord) sign beneath. Beautiful conservation. Pierced through the length for threading.
