



## A gold ring with a Roman red jasper intaglio. Private portrait of a woman.

Circa: 2nd century A.D.

Intaglio:  $1.3 \times 1.1 \text{ cm} (0 \frac{1}{2} \times 0 \frac{3}{8} \text{ inches})$ 

Mounting: gold (22k); UK size Q 1/2; Total weight 9,74 gr

Roman imperial, 2nd century A.D

The matrona is facing left, with her draped bust and the typical hairstyle inspired by Empress Faustina II (*c.130-176*).

Small chip at the top on the edge integrated by gold.
