



A Victorian mourning gold locket-ring with a nicolo.

Circa: mid 19th century

Stone: $1.4 \times 1.1 \text{ cm} (0^{-1}/_{2} \times 0^{-3}/_{8} \text{ inches})$

Mounting: gold (14k); UK size N $^{1/2}$; total weight 4,92 gr

This charming gold ring is set with a two-layers black and bluish agate. The locket is hinged at the side and originally retains its frame and glass. The exquisite hand engraving is feathery and extends to the bezel of the locket's top.

Hinge functions admirably.
