



A gold ring set with an Italic carnelian intaglio. Hand with attributes.

Circa: 2nd-1st century BCE

Intaglio: 9 x 8 mm

Mounting: Gold (9k); UK size L ³/₄ (resizable); total weight 4,95 g

Roman Italic, 2nd-1st century BCE on later gold ring.

A gold ring set with an Italic carnelian intaglio depicting a hand with attributes. A left hand holds an arrow, a symbol referable to hunting but also to Love (Eros). Note the use of globular elements in the engraving. The stone is slightly cabochon.
