



An Art Deco diamond and sapphire dress ring

Central stone: Old European cut diamond, approx. 0.61 ct

Accent stones: Calibre-cut sapphires, baguette-cut and single-cut diamonds

White gold or platinum (no assay marks)

Size: UK M½ — US 6.5

Gross weight: 3.5 g

Period: Art Deco style, 20th century

A striking Art Deco diamond and sapphire dress ring of bold geometric design. The central old European cut diamond, weighing approximately 0.61 carats, is set within an octagonal frame and encircled by a halo of calibre-cut sapphires of vivid cornflower blue — their tapered forms radiating outward like the rays of a sunburst.

The shoulders are elegantly articulated with baguette-cut diamonds flanked by small single-cut stones, continuing the architectural precision that defines the Art Deco aesthetic. The interplay of brilliant white diamonds against deep blue sapphires creates a striking contrast, at once refined and dramatic.

The mount, likely platinum or white gold, is unmarked but of fine quality, with clean lines and careful proportions characteristic of the period's finest jewellery. The ring sits comfortably on the finger and remains eminently wearable.

A superb example of Art Deco geometry and colour harmony — ideal as an engagement ring or a statement piece for the discerning collector.

Condition: Very good. Stones secure and bright. Light surface wear consistent with age.
