



BULGARI, two-colour "Parentesi Tubogas" diamond ring, vintage

18ct yellow gold & stainless steel

34 round brilliant-cut diamonds, 0.51 ct total, F colour, VS2 clarity

1980's

A two-colour ring by Bulgari from the Parentesi Tubogas line. The flexible body is formed of flat stainless steel Tubogas tubes, assembled without soldering, opening at the front onto two confronted terminals in solid 18ct yellow gold, each pavé-set with round brilliant-cut diamonds — 34 stones totalling 0.51 ct, F colour, VS2 clarity. The stepped "bracket" form of the gold terminals derives from the Parentesi motif, drawn from the travertine junctions of ancient Roman pavements. The sprung Tubogas construction allows the ring to adapt on the finger.
